RULES FOR DEPOSITING THE FEES & MODE OF PAYMENT

1. The fees will be accepted only quarterly. Deposit your ward's fee as per quarterly schedule to avoid inconvenience.

2. The fees counter will be open for depositing the fees through cash/cheque/online only between 7.35 am to 12.00 noon on all working days for avoiding any late fee charges of Rs. 10 per day.
3. Cheque should be made in favor of "VIDYA BAL BHAWAN SR. SEC. SCHOOL" for depositing the fees by cheque. If cheque is dishonored by the bank due to any reason, the penalty of Rs 500/- + Rs 10/- per day will be charged as the cheque bounce charges.
4. **The student's name will be struck off from the school rolls if fee will not be deposited by the last day of the 1st month of the quarter. In this situation re-admission will be allowed with the admission fee at the discretion of the Principal according to the re-admission policy.**
5. Students enrolled under EWS category need to update their EWS slip as per schedule.

Note: **Clear your all dues before starting of every examination to avoid any inconvenience on the day of the examination either PT/UT, half yearly, pre-board or Annual examination.**

School timing:

The school gate will be opened for the entry of the students at 7.35 am and closed sharp at 8.00 am. Late entry will not be allowed in any situation. Please do not argue with the security guard or school staff.

The security of the school is not giving the permission for taking lunch box, water bottle or any eatable items during the school hours.

Parents who escort the students for picking & dropping to school, please fix your place outside of the school & teach your ward to contact you on the designated place. If you are not available at that place, they will come back inside the school.

Parents who have dropping & picking the ward to the school through private vehicle, please do not drive on wrong side. This type of practice is encouraging your ward for breaking rules. Please do not drop your ward in front of the main gate or park the vehicle in front of the gate.

Please check your ward's summer school uniform in advance, so that your ward comes school as per perfect uniform. The perfect uniform means - as per your ward length, size, colours, pattern & design of the dress. If any discrepancy in the uniform, immediately purchase the correct uniform.


